Immediate challenges


- Concern for friends and colleagues working across the globe
- Restrictions on travel
- Differences between countries & their capacities to undertake virtual and remote working
- Lack of clarity about how different projects will be impacted
- Uncertainty about if individual projects can continue



What do we know?

- 'No-cost' extension requests to grants impacted by coronavirus will be allowed if they are funded by UKRI.
- If travel has been paid for but can not happen this is still an eligible cost
- GCRF call deadlines for new projects have been extended by a few weeks
- There have been no changes to the reporting requirements of current GCRF QR supported requirements (as yet).
- There is a lot of discussion ongoing about costed extensions but this will have implications for future programmes.
- Some changes to the DAC list is expected (e.g China and India may be removed).
